
Developing Effective Dental Leaders Through Emotional Intelligence

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How Does Emotional Intelligence In Leaders Affect An **Organisation's Functioning and Profitability?**

Having leaders with low emotional intelligence is costly for business.

Revenue

- Teams led by leaders with well-developed emotional intelligence outperformed other teams by 15-20% on yearly revenue targets.
- Leaders who possess higher empathy, self-regard, reality testing, and problem solving are more likely to head profitable businesses.

Retention

- Employees who had managers with high emotional intelligence were four times more likely to stay with the same business than those who worked with managers who had low Emotional Intelligence.
- Depending on the size of a business, the total costs of replacing an employee varies from 30-150% of their salary. (PeopleKeep 2023)

Performance

- Leaders who lacked EI were rarely rated as outstanding in their performance reviews and, their teams under performed by an average of 20%.
- 100% of respondents stated that knowing their El strengths and opportunities helped them in transitioning to a higher level role.


